

Common Problematic Materials

- Sediments/sludge
- Road Material
- Recycled/Crushed Concrete
- Bricks,
- Coal ash/MSW incinerator ash
- ACM
- RCRA Wastes
- Slags/tailings/foundry sand

Common Problematic Scenarios

- unregulated fill at schools, playgrounds, daycares, and residential properties.
- Gravel pits
- Wetlands
- Farmland

Ongoing Challenge

- Significant Volume of Historic Fill still being improperly managed
- Significant Volume Historic Fill is ending up in the inappropriate location
- Much fill moved beyond state jurisdiction
- Many developers look for "deal on fill"

Identification of Historic Fill Areas

- Review of Historic Maps and Other Historical Data (e.g. Sanborn Maps)
- Review Site Assessments, Soil Borings, etc
- Information Review of information from National Resource Conservation Service (NRCS)
